# HOCHTIEF gains infrastructure orders totalling EUR 116 million in Poland

### **New terminal at Wroclaw Airport - Silesian Stadium in Chorzow to be extended**

HOCHTIEF has received contracts in Poland totalling almost EUR 116 million. HOCHTIEF Polska will construct a new terminal for more than EUR 54 million (PLN 243 million) at the Wroclaw Strachowice (Breslau) Airport. The company will also head a syndicate to expand the Silesian Stadium in Chorzów, near Kattowitz. The contract has a volume of almost EUR 62 million (PLN 277 million). Of this EUR 32 million (PLN 144 million) relates to HOCHTIEF Polska.

The new terminal in Breslau will have a surface area of 40,000 square meters. Furthermore, HOCHTIEF Polska will build access roads and peripheral areas as well as 1,000 parking spaces. The expanded airport is to process two and a half times as many passengers per year as is currently the case. Construction starts as early as July and is to be finished in March 2011.

After the work is finished, the Silesian Stadium will be expanded to seat 55,000 sports fans - 8,000 more than before - and will meet UEFA and FIFA standards. Construction work will start in the fall of 2009 and will be completed in the second half of 2011.
